


Figure 1: Photograph of faculty members & students participating in Har Ghar Tiranga campaign

Neki Ki Dukan

Shri Pragya Mahavidyalaya organized a social service campaign titled "Neki ki Dukan" on 20th September, 2021 highlighting the significant educational disparities between urban and rural areas. It underscored the critical role that access to study materials plays in bridging this gap and enhancing the learning experiences of rural students. The lack of stationery aid and learning materials is the chief cause for this amongst diverse other factors. Restricted access to universal quality education is a major challenge for development when it comes to remote areas in India. Lack of awareness amongst the communities and poverty are the major factors resulting in the non-attendance of schools by children in these areas.

Localities from Bijainagar submitted their left-over stuffs that can be used by others like toys, stationery items, clothes, bottles, footwear. Some new stationery items were also bought by college. The material received was distributed in various schools. 600 copies, 120 pencil packets, 100 pen packets, 70 bottles, 70 lunch boxes, utensils and clothes and other collected material were distributed in schools like Government Primary School Keriya, Satavadiya, Government Upper Primary School, Daulatpura, Government Girls Upper Primary School, Tokarwad, Government Primary School, Bheelon Ki Badiya and Adarsh Vidya Mandir Secondary School, Bijaynagar etc. Apart from this, material was given secretly to seven needy families. In this distribution program, the members of Nanak Shravak Samiti, Prakash Bai Ji Pokharna and the executive of Balika Parishad and girls were present.

The event concluded with an interactive discussion where participants, including students and faculty, shared their experiences and suggestions for enhancing educational support in rural areas. In his closing remarks, the principal expressed gratitude to the speakers, participants and organizers for their dedication to this cause. 


Figure 4: Photograph captured the moment students received their study materials




Figure 5 : Photograph of members of Shravak Sangh, Balika Parishad, faculty members and students participating in Neki ki Dukan campaign




Figure 1: Photograph of Students showing their innovations in Science Exhibition




Figure 1: Photograph of Posters Made by Students on Vaccination Day




Figure 6: Photograph of NDRF Team Instructing Students about The Disaster Management




Figure 1: Photograph of Art made by student
