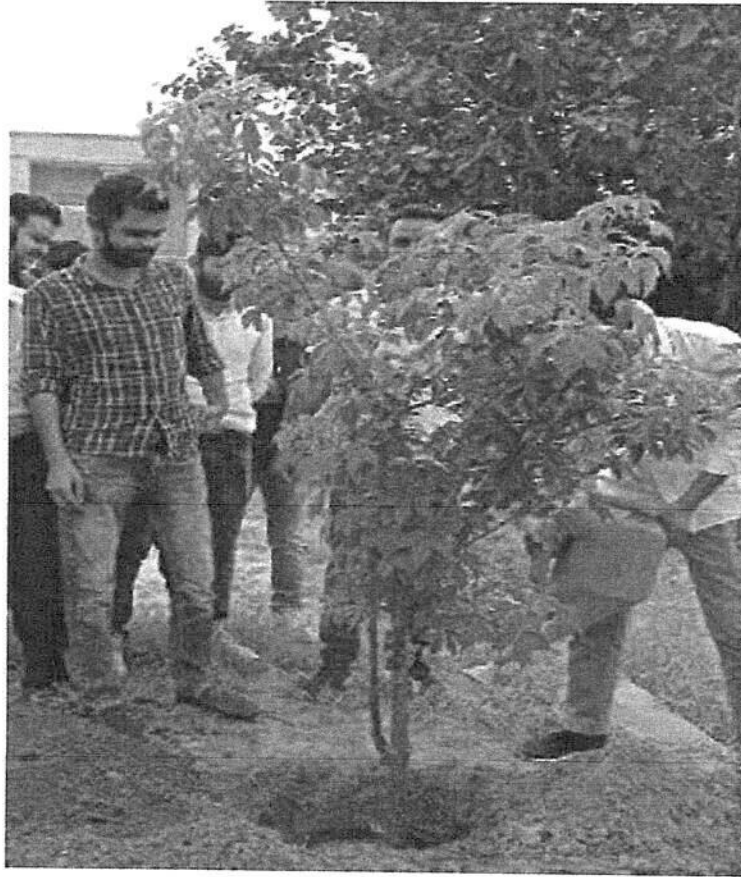


Figure 1: Photograph of Faculty Members Planting Trees

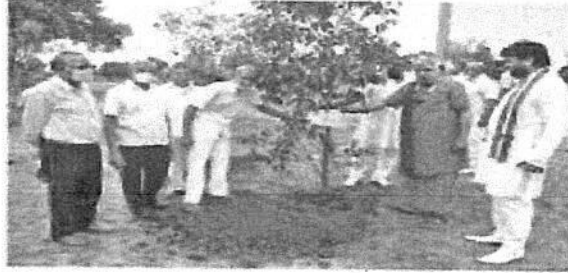

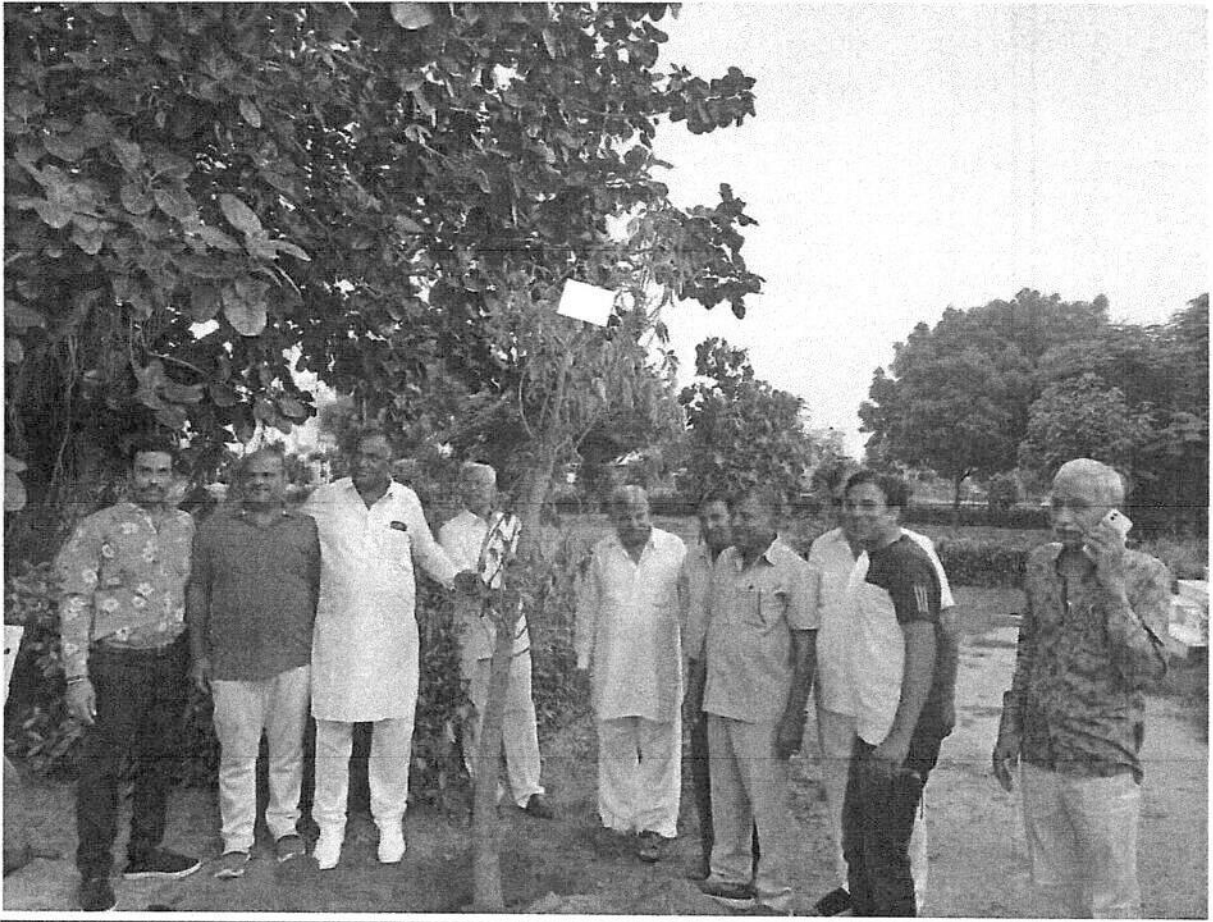


Figure 1: Photographs of Guests planting trees

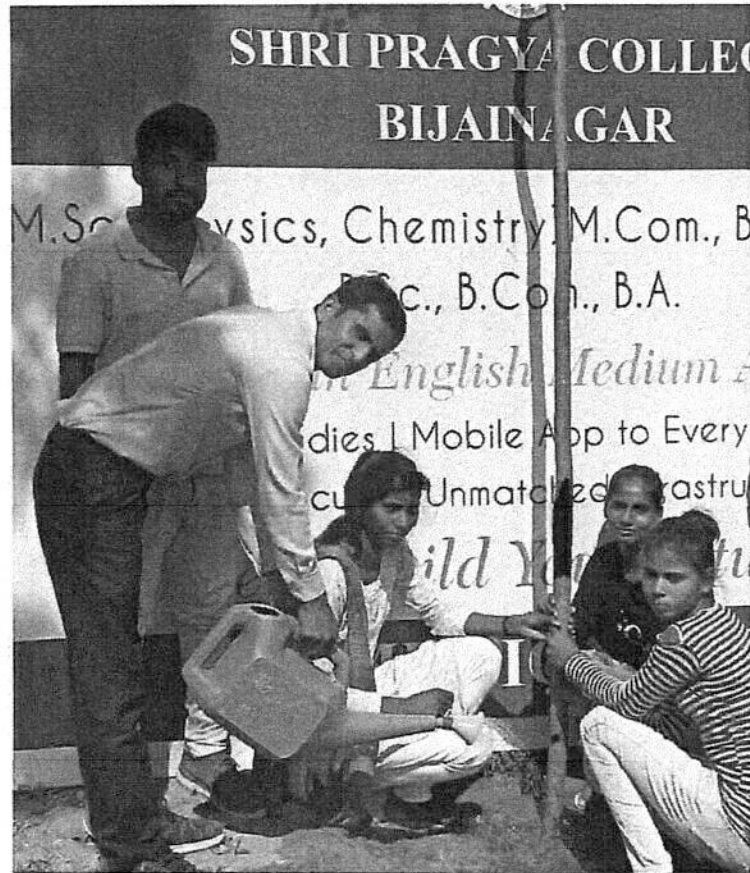


Figure 2: Tree Plantation by students and faculty member
