**Uses**

1. Ornamental plant: Used for landscaping and beautification due to its tall, slender form.
2. Avenue planting: Commonly planted along roadsides for its aesthetic appeal.
3. Hedge or screen: Effective as a natural privacy screen or windbreak.
4. Air purifier: Helps improve air quality by absorbing pollutants.
5. Shade provider: Offers shade in urban and rural areas.
6. Noise reduction: Acts as a natural sound barrier when planted in rows.
7. Medicinal uses: Leaves and bark are used in traditional medicine for treating fever and skin diseases.
8. Antibacterial properties: Extracts from the plant have antibacterial effects.
9. Antifungal properties: Used to combat fungal infections.
10. Timber source: The wood is lightweight and used for making small furniture or handicrafts.
