Uses

1. Ornamental plant: Often used for landscaping due to its striking flowers and size.
2. Shade provider: The large canopy provides significant shade, making it ideal for park settings.
3. Timber source: The wood is used in making furniture, boats, and tools.
4. Fiber extraction: The fibers of the fruit are used to make mattresses, pillows, and cushions.
5. Medicinal use: The tree is used in traditional medicine for treating wounds, skin diseases, and inflammations.
6. Anti-inflammatory: Extracts from the bark and leaves are used to reduce inflammation.
7. Pain relief: Parts of the plant are used in folk medicine to relieve pain.

9. Diuretic: The tree's leaves and bark are used to promote urine production in traditional remedies.
